A pronouncement: 2 "The word of Jehovah concerning Israel," is the utterance of Jehovah, the One who is stretching out [the] heavense and laying the foundation of [the] earth and forming the spirit of man* inside him. 2 "Here I am making Jerusalemh a bowl [causing] reeling to all the peoples round about;i and also against Judah he will come to be in the siege, [even] against Jerusalem. 3 And it must occur in that day^k [that] I shall make Jerusalem a burdensome stone to all the peoples. All those lifting it will without fail get severe scratches for themselves; and against her all the nations of the earth will certainly be gathered.m 4 In that day,"n is the utterance of Jehovah, "I shall strike every horse° with bewilderment and its rider with madness;p and upon the house of Judah I shall open my eyes,q and every horse of the peoples I shall strike with loss of sight. 5 And the sheiks of Judah will have to say in their heart, 'The inhabitants of Jerusalem are a strength to me by Jehovah of armies their God.'*s 6 In that day I shall make the sheiks of Judah like a firepot among treest and like a fiery torch in a row of newly cut grain," and they must devour on the right [hand] and on the left all the peoples round about; v and Jerusalem must yet be inhabited in her [own] place, in Jerusalem.w

7 "And Jehovah will certainly save the tents of Judah first, to the end that the beauty of the house of David and the beauty of the inhabitants of Jerusalem may not become too great over Judah. 8 In that day Jehovah will be a defense around the inhabitants of Jerusalem;" and the one that is stumbling
